

Greater Waterbury LIST (Local Interagency Service Team)
2017/2018 Music and Arts Contest official rules

- Contest is open to all Elementary, Middle School and High Students in the following towns:
 - Ansonia, Beacon Falls, Cheshire, Derby, Middlebury, Naugatuck, Oxford, Prospect, Seymour, Southbury, Waterbury, Wolcott
- Entries can be of any artistic format and must include positive school attendance messages
 - Examples include: graphic arts, visual arts, music, poetry, and dance
 - Any combination of arts will also be accepted
 - All performances should be audio or video recorded- the recording submitted as entry
- All entries must be accompanied by a signed release (by parent or guardian if under 18)
 - Each participant needs a separate signed release
- Entries can be individual or by a group
- Audio/Visual entries can be 1- 3 minutes in length
- Music/ Rap entries: Music/lyrics must be original and be accepted by sound cloud
 - Background beats available upon request

- Entries will be judged on how well they address the theme, the quality of the production and student creativity. Professional video assistance cannot be provided to produce or edit the final product
- Entries cannot contain profanity, sexual content, inappropriate words/behavior as determined by the LIST members when reviewing submissions
